The ISU Alumni Pep Band recorded another perfect record for the 2006-2007 basketball season. Included in the wins were two Men's and one Women's basketball game.

To get the season started off right, we added a few new songs to the folders, and both the band and the crowd enjoyed the new tunes. The Alumni Pep Band said "Hello" to Greg McDermott and, with the 57-49 victory over Norfolk State, helped him become the third ISU coach in history to win his first four games.

Savannah State was the next Alumni Pep Band/ISU opponent on December 13th. The cold December Wednesday was warmed a bit by the hot pizza dinner, and the arrival of several Alumni Band first-timers was a welcomed sight. The game itself was a back and forth affair, but the ISU men pulled away at the end to defeat the Tigers 70-59.

On January 3rd the band helped ring in the new year with Bill Fennelly's team taking on the University of Kansas. Although the pesky Jayhawks usually gives ISU fits, this year the end result was a good one. A bunch of free throws at the end of the evening helped ISU to a comfortable win, 61-50.

Golden Alumni Shuttle

Transportation to and from Scheman and Jack Trice Stadium will be available on Saturday to any Alumni Band member or guest who cannot make the journey on foot. If you would like to reserve a seat on the shuttle, please indicate this on your registration form.

Instruments

The Iowa State University Band Department will supply the following instruments for those who will need them on Saturday, October 20:

Marching French Horns
Baritones
Sousaphones
Percussion

If you need to borrow one of these instruments, please make sure you designate this on your registration form. Due to a limited number of horns available, it is first come, first served.

If you need to borrow an instrument, other than those listed above, please do your best to try and locate a horn from another source (local schools, music shops, friends). It is very time consuming for the band staff to gather all the necessary equipment at one of its busiest times of the year. However, in the rare instance that you cannot locate a horn, please mark your registration form accordingly.

If you do borrow an instrument from the ISU Band Department, you will need to bring your own lyre, reed, etc.

You are responsible for returning the instrument to its proper place after the game!

Room Reservations

The Alumni Band has a block of 20 rooms reserved on October 19th at the University Inn, located at 229 South Duff Avenue. The block room rate is \$80 for a non-smoking room with two double beds. The block will be reserved through Sunday, October 14, and after that date any remaining rooms will be released to the general public. Football Tickets

Tickets purchased privately cannot be used by members of the Alumni Band for admission to Jack Trice Stadium. This is an Athletic Department policy that the Alumni Band has no control over. In the past, individuals have subtracted the cost of a ticket from their registration fee. The Alumni Band will not be able to cover this expense.

Saturday Meal at Scheman

Everyone planning to join us at Scheman will need a meal ticket. These meal tickets will be in the packets you receive during check-in on Friday night or Saturday morning. Your registration fee covers this meal for you. Please mark the number of extra meal tickets needed on your registration form. Tickets are necessary as Scheman catering calculates our meal charges based on a per plate count.

ISU Alumni Band Meeting
October 21, 2006
Scheman Building

President Mark Sobek called the meeting to order.

The Homecoming 2006 alumni band will be made up of 165 members traveling from 16 different states and representing seven decades of ISU alums. President Sobek recognized the attendees from each decade and introduced the executive board members.

Director of Bands Report: Dr. Mike Golemo addressed the group and shared greetings from former director Marty Province, who is currently in Arizona. On behalf of the alumni band, Dr. Golemo presented a gift to Dennis Goering for his work as alumni band president during our 25th anniversary year. The ISU Foundation has a new representative to work with the Adopt-the-Band fund raising program. Approximately \$90,000 was raised last year; this is slightly down from previous years, but was primarily cash gifts rather than deferred gifts. The alumni band purchased four used brass sousaphones this year. Instrument purchases for the varsity band included ten sousaphones and new snare, bass and tenor drums.

Associate Director of Bands Report: Matt Smith shared some news from the varsity band. Based on feedback from band members, a day was added to the preseason band camp to spend more time on fundamentals. He feels this has greatly improved their performance this year and allowed them to spend less time on fundamentals in daily rehearsals. The band has grown over the past couple years to 317 members, including 29 sousas, and the retention rate is about 90%. The band cannot grow much larger due to space limitations, which may necessitate serious auditions for wind players and may prevent the band from automatically accepting returning members. Fans have been very receptive of the increased use of pictures in shows this year.

President-Elect Jay Chapman introduced this year's varsity band scholarship recipients: Parker Lohrenz and Mike Atkinson.

Election Results: Secretary – Donna Drefke; Newsletter – Candy Bless and Chris Colvin; Treasurer – Susan Sobek; Public Relations – John Kauffman and Rob Morrison; Director-at-Large – Brad Gerndt, Bob Fitch and Charles Martin.

Pep Band: There are three opportunities to participate in alumni band pep bands this year, and we are gathering names of Ames-Des Moines area members who would be willing to play at ad hoc area events. Registration forms go to Michelle Langston.

Fund Raising: The raffle, silent auction and merchandise sales generated about \$1,000 this weekend. The raffle grand prize winner of free registration and hotel for Homecoming 2007 is Rod Logan.

Recognition: The group acknowledged members attending their first alumni band reunion, members who have attended all 26 years, and members attending every year they have been eligible. The member traveling the farthest distance to attend came from Venice, California. Lorna Livingston received the Chester Smith Award recognizing the oldest alum.

President Sobek thanked Dennis Goering and Jay Chapman for their assistance during the past year and then adjourned the meeting.

Next meeting: Homecoming 2007, October 19-20.

Run for the 2007-2008 Executive Board Get Involved!

The Executive Board meets three to four times a year in connection with regularly scheduled Alumni Band functions on campus. You don't need to live in the Ames area to serve. You can participate in meetings via conference call if your schedule doesn't permit a trip to Ames. This is a great opportunity to become more involved with the inner workings of the Alumni Band. The Executive Board - among other things - plans all Alumni Band functions, conducts fundraising, and helps support the Varsity Band.

DUTIES

President (Three-year commitment) shall be the executive officer of the Alumni Band and the Executive Board. Will conduct all meetings, sign for the organization, and appoint committees as needed.

Secretary (One-year term) shall keep minutes of all meetings, distribute them to all members of the Executive Board immediately following the meeting, and carry out correspondence.

Treasurer (One-year term) shall maintain financial records of all income and expenses, prepare reports for each major event, distribute reports in a timely manner to the Executive Board, and carry out other duties as assigned.

Newsletter Editors (2) (One-year term) shall chronicle the meetings and appearances of the Alumni Band so that members unable to attend may be apprised of the events.

Directors-At-Large (3) (Two-year term) shall advise and consult as part of the Executive Board at all meetings and shall carry out other duties as assigned.

ELECTIONS

Band members will have an opportunity to vote via the written ballot either during Friday night festivities or during the Saturday meal. It is each member's responsibility to cast a ballot.

Votes will be tallied on Saturday and the results will be announced during the annual business meeting.

HOW TO APPLY

1. Select a position.
2. Nominate yourself: Include with your registration form a short 2 to 3 sentence biography.
3. Participate during Homecoming activities. You will have a special name tag to wear announcing your candidacy. Your biography will be posted for viewing Friday night and Saturday morning.
