



OUTSTANDING YOUNG ALUMNI AWARD – Nomination Form

The Iowa State University Alumni Association established this award in 1968 to recognize ISU alumni, age 40 and under, who have excelled in their professions and provided service to their communities.

Up to three awards may be granted annually. (Current members of the ISU Alumni Association staff, board of directors, and awards committee are ineligible to receive this award.)

Guidelines for submitting a successful-award nomination:

- Be sure to read the award descriptions carefully to ensure you are nominating the person for the award that fits the nominee most appropriately.
- The information submitted by the nominator is what will be used to determine the strength of the award nomination. Be thorough with the submitted information.
- To best represent your nominee, please follow the nomination format closely. Respond to the criteria requirements in the numerical order as listed under the Selection Criteria heading. Essay type submissions that don't follow the exact criteria order make it difficult to capture the necessary information to meet selection guidelines.
- Only three recommendation letters will be accepted. Additional attachments (other than a resume) or information and recommendation letters will not be considered so that each nominee is judged equally in the selection process.

1. Nominator's summary explaining why this person should be chosen for this award and the professional and community service achievements that qualify the candidate for this award
2. List relevant employment positions held
3. List awards, honors, or recognitions, related to their profession or community service
4. List local, state, national and/or international activities

Nominations are kept on file for one year following the year in which it was originally considered, if not selected that first year and until age limitation has expired. Nominators are encouraged to update nomination materials yearly.
